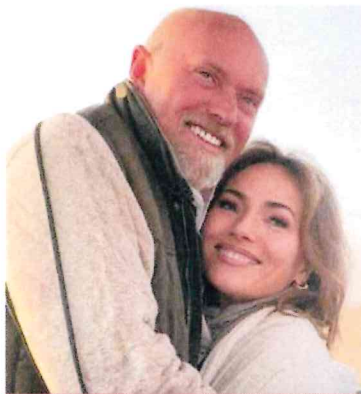

# Itinerary *Subject to Change*

## Day 1 – Amsterdam (Embarkation)

Embark your ship in Amsterdam for your 7-night cruise.

## Day 2 – Amsterdam → Kampen

Enjoy a scenic cruise through the IJsselmeer to Kampen. Venture to the charming, canal-laden village of Giethoorn, nicknamed the “Dutch Venice.” Capture photos of picturesque thatched-roof farmhouses that look straight out of a fairytale.

In the afternoon, choose between a guided walking tour through the Dutch countryside or a visit to Flevoland’s vibrant tulip fields.

## Day 3 – Bruinisse

After a scenic cruise through the Delta, join a guided tour of Zierikzee, a medieval harbor town filled with charm—from its 16th-century Gravesteen to harborside shops and cafés. Includes a photo stop at the Oosterschelde storm surge barrier, part of the Delta Works.

Optional excursions include:

- Delta Works & Flood Museum (Neeltje Jans)
- Guided bike tour of Bruinisse

## Day 4 – Ghent / Bruges, Belgium

Explore Ghent’s canal-side architecture, including Castle of the Counts and St. Bavo’s Cathedral with the Adoration of the Mystic Lamb.

Optional experiences:

- Chocolate workshop with master chocolatier (including tasting and praline-making)
- Full-day excursion to Bruges, a UNESCO World Heritage Site featuring Grote Markt, Burg Square, and the Church of Our Lady

## Day 5 – Antwerp

Visit the Floralia spring flower show featuring over one million hand-planted bulbs, or enjoy a culinary tour featuring Belgian chocolate, waffles, and beer.

Later, explore Antwerp on a walking tour including Steen Castle, Grote Markt, Brabo Fountain, and the Cathedral of Our Lady. Optional guided bike tour available.

## Day 6 – Dordrecht → Rotterdam

Visit Kinderdijk, a UNESCO World Heritage Site known for its 18th-century windmills. Tour a private windmill via electric boat.

Continue to Rotterdam for a walking tour of the “Gateway to Europe,” including a visit to the Market Hall. Optional excursions include:

- Royal Delft Porcelain Factory & Museum
- Rotterdam architecture tour

## Day 7 – Amsterdam

Enjoy a scenic morning cruise before an afternoon canal cruise aboard a smaller boat designed for Amsterdam’s bridges. See historic canals, waterfront homes, and the Skinny Bridge.

Optional excursion:

- Keukenhof Gardens (seasonal, when open), featuring millions of tulips across 70 acres, known as the “Garden of Europe.”

*Note: Included on most departures. Alternate tours operate when Keukenhof is closed.*

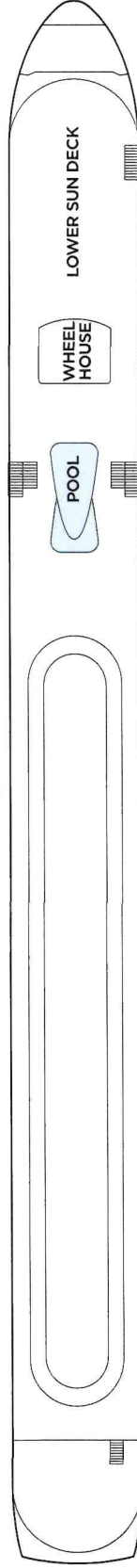

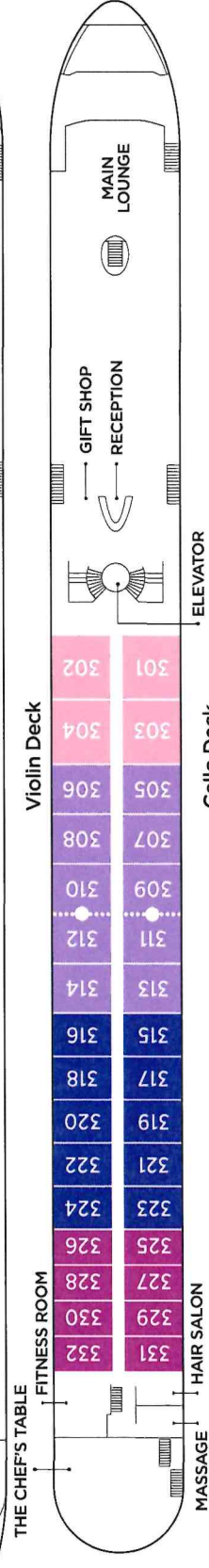

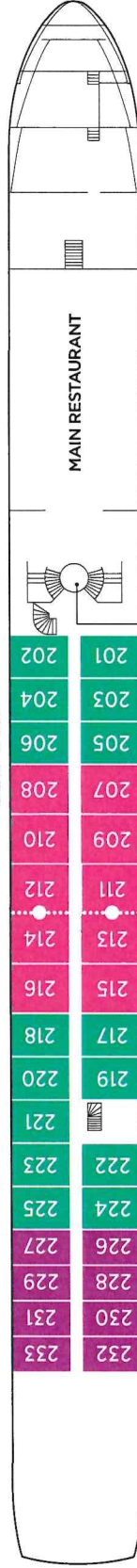
Sun Deck

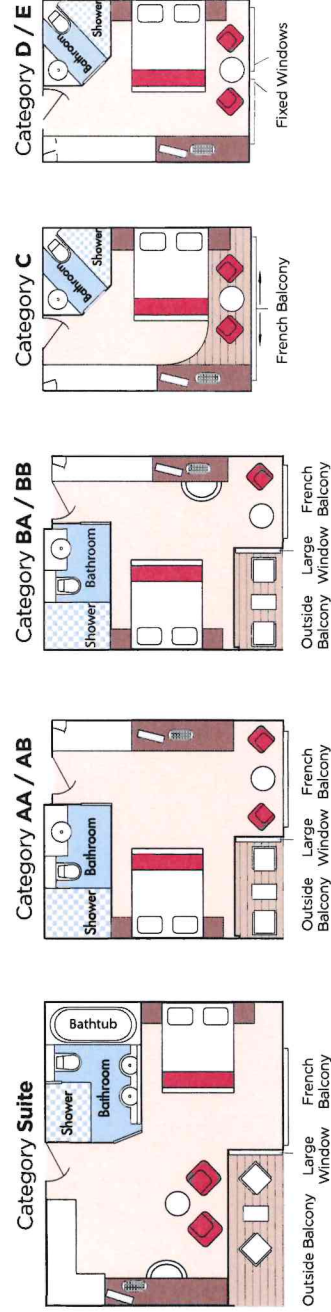


Elevator reaches Main Restaurant, Lobby/Main Lounge and staterooms on Violin and Cello Deck.
